Formal trial lawyer Jonathan F. Putnam continues to impress fans of the Civil War era and historical mysteries with his expertise on one of the most important presidents in American history, Abraham Lincoln. Putnam's third mystery, *Final Resting Place*, is inspired by real events and delves even deeper into Lincoln's past. It is the summer of 1838, and Springfield is embroiled in a tumultuous, violent political season. All of Springfield's elite have gathered at a grand party to celebrate the Fourth of July. Spirits are high until a prominent local politician is assassinated in the midst of fireworks. When his political rival is arrested, young lawyer Lincoln and his best friend Joshua Speed are back on the case to investigate. It's no ordinary trial, however, as Lincoln and Speed soon face unwelcome complications.
